Situated within walking distance of Dorchester town centre and train stations, just behind the new 'Brewery Square' development, the house is comfortable, welcoming and warm in winter.

The heart of the house is our **Quiet Room** and Library, where weekly meetings for Christian Meditation take place.



There are eight bedrooms, two twin and six single bedrooms. All rooms have wash hand basins, with a bath or shower room situated on each floor.



Towels, soap and bed linen are provided. Coffee and tea making facilities are in all rooms.



Kitchen facilities are modern and efficient with a large Dining Room adjacent.



The beautiful garden is newly affiliated to the Quiet Garden Movement and is ideal for quiet reflection, with use of a summer house.

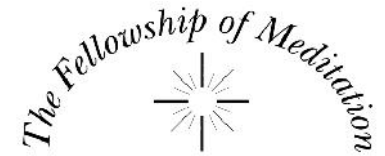
